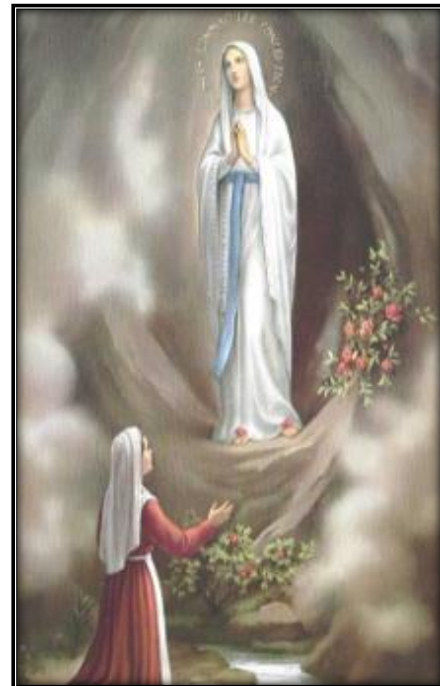

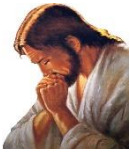
St. Martin of Tours Gumbo:
